- A written composition of at least 300 words on "Why I want to become a nurse or pursue an advanced degree in Nursing?"

AWARD POLICY

1. The Scholarship Grant in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) dollars taken from the PNAM Scholarship Fund account will be awarded to each of the two awardees, one (1) undergraduate, and one (1) graduate.
2. The award will be paid directly to the educational institution.
3. The applicant must provide the most current official Transcript of Records directly mailed to PNAM as proof of current academic standing and GPA.
4. The completed scholarship application must meet the deadline as specified by PNAM.
5. The PNAM Scholarship winner(s) will be presented at the PNAM Inaugural Ball.
6. The awardee (s) must be present to receive the scholarship award. If the award recipient(s) is unable to attend the PNAM Inaugural Ball, the award money will be returned to the PNAM Scholarship Fund account.
7. The applicant must be a member of PNAM prior to applying for the scholarship.
8. The awardee (s) must be a member of PNAM for at least two years after receiving the award, as a regular member (for the graduate) or as a student member (for the undergraduate).
9. PNAM may choose more than one award recipient from either category if one of the categories does not have a qualified applicant.
10. All the criteria set forth must be met by the applicants.
