Who is Eligible to Get Vaccinated?

- 1 Individuals ages 6 months and older who need their first or second dose of Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine, or bivalent Pfizer or Moderna booster.
- 2 The flu shot and COVID-19 vaccines can be given the same day.
- 3 Please bring insurance information (if possible), and photo identification.
- 4 You do not need insurance to get vaccinated at this clinic. The COVID-19 vaccine and flu shot are free for you at this clinic.
- 5 Flu shots will only be available for people 65 years and older at this clinic.

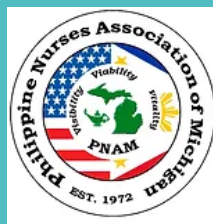
Per CDC guidelines, people can mix and match COVID-19 vaccines.
